

Al Ekhaa School for Boys: International Path

Admission and Registration Policy

General Objective:

To determine the requirements and conditions for identification and related others documents for students' registration in schools under the umbrella of the Saudi Arabian Ministry of Education's Private Education Department.

School Admissions Policy Steps

- For school admission, the applicant must complete three-years of age to enter KG1, four years of age for KG2, five years of age for KG3, and five years and nine months of age for 1st Grade.
- Completion of the registration documents provided by the Ministry of Education is as follows:

Requirements to complete the student registration process:

- 3 personal ID photos.
- A copy of the vaccination card.
- A copy of the birth certificate.
- A copy of the National family card.
- A certificate of the last grade completed by the student (certified if the certificate is from outside Turkey or transferred from one track to another).
- A copy of a valid passport (for non-Saudis) for both students and parents (mother and father).
- A copy of valid residence ID card (for non-Saudis) for both the student and parents.
- A verification letter from the primary parent's work.
- Interviews, oral and written tests are conducted for all applicants to determine their level of education. These examinations are simplified, and they are aimed to investigate the extent of the student's fundamentals knowledge of the course he will be taking.
- The student will have a personal interview with specialist to determine his/her social and behavioral competence at school and further prepare any special needs for the student.
- During the start of registration of new students, a form of his/her social & health status will be completed.

Renewing student's registration

- In order to guarantee places for your children in school each year, we ask parents to accelerate the registration of their children during the school's working hours.
- If the student's guardian didn't book a place for his child for the new academic year, this will be considered as unwillingness to continue with Al-Ekhaa Schools-International Path. As a result, the NIS may be forced to allocate unreserved places for the new students.
